

pdnet Level 2 Training

Launch Event! Wednesday 21st April at 4:00pm

Level 2 training is designed for support staff in mainstream or special education. This training builds on the learning from the Level 1 training and covers the concepts, principles and core skills needed to provide effective support.

It consists of eight units with each taking approximately an hour and a half to complete. Each unit has workbook activities and a case study to support participants to reflect and apply their learning.









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Key areas of learning

Key themes

- Understanding types of physical disability and its implications
- Providing effective support to learners with physical disability
- Understanding legislation on equality and inclusion
- Providing a child centred, inclusive environment
- Consider the school's role and responsibility in supporting learners

- Listening and responding to pupil voice
- Working with parent/carers
- Positive multi-agency working
- Building emotional resilience and independence
- Managing movement, mobility and access needs
- Celebrating the uniqueness and diversity of learners with a physical disability
- Managing risk and developing independence for learners









In addition, the training contains pupil profiles which detail good practice in supporting learners with physical disability in a mainstream setting. Also included are Individual Health Care Plans which provide an example of the documentation that needs to be available in school for the pupil's medical condition, physical disability and other needs.

'This interactive online training resource comprehensively covers the knowledge and skills needed to provide effective support for learners with a physical disability. The course is engaging, with a good variety of video, text and interactive activities.

The supporting workbook and case study tasks are useful in giving staff the opportunity to reflect and apply learning to their own school. The pupil profiles and Individual Health Care Plans are particularly helpful in describing good practice and providing examples of the documentation needed in school.
