



Procedure for a pupil pushing a young person in a wheelchair

A member of SMT is responsible for carrying out, or overseeing a **risk assessment**, including specialist and medical advice where necessary.

This should include;



Risks to the pupil being pushed Risks to the pupil pushing the wheelchair Environmental hazards To only use wheelchair accessible areas of the school Whether another pupil accompanies them to open doors Whether the pupil will need adult support for personal care



- The school should select and name the pupils to push the wheelchair based on their professional judgement, health needs and with the consent of the child using the wheelchair.
- Agreement must be sought in writing from all sets of parents
- The named pupils need to have established guidelines to follow and have received training in how to push the chair in the school environment



- There must be an emergency procedure agreed and communicated to the pupils in the event of an emergency evacuation.
- All school staff need to be notified who the pupils are with this responsibility. For example, this can be done through a briefing, a laminated card given to the pupil or a badge demonstrating the responsibility.
- The school need to regularly update the risk assessment to reflect any changes.
