### Transition Resource

### Level 2 Training: Supporting Learners with Physical Disability

Level 2 training is designed for support staff in mainstream or special education. This training builds on the learning from the Level 1 training and covers the concepts, principles and core skills needed to provide effective support.

It consists of eight units with each taking approximately an hour and a half to complete. Each unit has workbook activities and a case study to support participants to reflect and apply their learning.

#### Key areas of learning include:

- ✓ Understanding types of physical disability and its implications
- ✓ Providing effective support to learners with physical disability
- ✓ Understanding legislation on equality and inclusion
- ✓ Providing a child centred, inclusive environment
- ✓ Consider the school's role and responsibility in supporting learners
- ✓ Exploring the support role for learners

#### Key themes:

- Listening and responding to pupil voice
- Working with parent/carers
- Positive multi-agency working
- Building emotional resilience and independence
- Managing movement, mobility and access needs
- Celebrating the uniqueness and diversity of learners with a physical disability
- Managing risk and developing independence for learners

### Level 1 Training

These online training modules (early years, school, post 16) are designed for anyone working within an educational setting who needs to develop their awareness and understanding of physical disability and the impact it can have on learning.

Each module is approximately one hour in length and uses custom graphics and scenario-based learning to help users to understand the barriers or challenges that can be faced by children and young people with a physical disability and the steps that can be taken to overcome these.
